Chris Lowney chairs the board of Catholic Health Initiatives, one of the nation's largest healthcare/hospital systems. He formerly served as a Managing Director of J.P. Morgan & Co in New York, Tokyo, Singapore and London until leaving the firm in 2001. He has lectured in more than two-dozen countries on leadership, business ethics, and other related topics.

He is the author of five books, including the bestselling *Heroic Leadership* and *Pope Francis: Why He Leads the Way He Leads*, which was called "a book for the ages" and became the # 1 bestseller on Amazon's "Popes and the Vatican" list.

Chris's most recent work is, "[Everyone Leads: How to Revitalize the Catholic Church](#)." During his talk, Chris will explore some of the profound challenges now facing the Church and will invite each of us to step up and help lead the Church's revitalization.
